Award of Merit

Christine Eckel, DMD

Christine Eckel has shown a long-term commitment to hospital dentistry and to the care of patients with major disabilities.

She has been on staff at the George Pearson, Vancouver General and BC Children's hospitals

for nearly 35 years. During this time, Christine has devoted Fridays to treating patients with major diseases and injuries at the George Pearson Hospital clinic.

She has also taught techniques and dental care management for these types of patients to UBC dental students.

Christine's involvement with CDSBC goes back 30 years. She served as a director to the Vancouver and District Dental Society and a representative to the CDSBC Board. She was also a member of the Review Committee for eight years, two of which she served as sub-chair, and was a volunteer for the Communications, Public Relations and Convention Committees.

Since graduating from the University of Saskatchewan with a Doctorate of Dental Medicine in 1974, Christine has practised public health dentistry in Calgary, and completed an internship in hospital dentistry at Toronto's Hospital for Sick Children.

Ian Leitch, DMD

Ian Leitch has made an inspiring impact on the dental profession and the community.

Ian has been involved with CDSBC since 1998. He was a member of the Quality Assurance Committee, and was the Okanagan representa-

tive to the Peer Review Committee for nine years.

Ian graduated from UBC with a Doctorate of Dental Medicine in 1983. Two years later, he became a director of the Kelowna and District Dental Society and held that position for five years. During this time, Ian was also a CDSBC representative for the Dialogue in Dentistry Committee, where his role was to educate companies about the pitfalls of capitation when considering insurance options.

From 1999 to 2008, Ian donated more than \$30,000 from an in-office tooth-whitening program to 21 local charities. In addition, he spearheaded a committee to develop a dental clinic at the Kelowna Gospel Mission.

Since 2004, this clinic has provided free dental treatment to the homeless and underprivileged in Kelowna. The clinic has also coordinated a program to produce dentures for people in need.

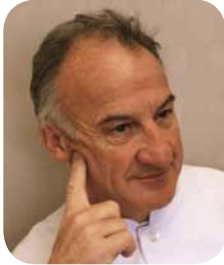
In 2010, Ian was awarded the "Spirit of Kelowna" award by Mayor Sharon Shepherd for his support in initiating this clinic.

Ian holds three fellowships: the International College of Dentists; the Pierre Fauchard Academy; and the American College of Dentists.

Distinguished Service Award

This award recognizes outstanding and broad contributions to the profession in B.C. and to CDSBC over a sustained period of time. It may be awarded to people who are not registered or certified with CDSBC.



John Carpendale, DMD, MSD, Certified Specialist (Prosthodontics)

John Carpendale's dedication to the dental profession has led him to hold several varied positions as a consultant, leader and educator.

John has volunteered for CDSBC as far back as 1994, when he first served on the Dental Technician Denturist Advisory Committee. Since that time, he has served on the Task Force on Dental Technicians' Legislation, the Article 16 Working Group, and was the Specialist Society Representative on CDSBC Council and former chair of the Practice Standards Committee.

John is currently Chair of the CDSBC Inquiry Committee, and has been commended for his attention to detail, unfailing professionalism and calm and efficient demeanour in chairing meetings.

John received his undergraduate degree from Trinity College in Dublin, Ireland in 1979. After this, he embarked on a post-graduate dentistry program at Indiana University in the United States, where he received his specialty in prosthodontics and a masters degree in dental science.

At present, John is a clinical assistant professor at the UBC Faculty of Dentistry, and the prosthodontic consultant and provincial leader at the British Columbia Cancer Agency.

John has lectured nationally and internationally on his specialty, and is an acting mentor for several continuing education study clubs in British Columbia. He served two terms as president of the BC Society of Prosthodontists and the Dental Specialists Society of BC, and was recently elected to the American College of Dentists.

John practises in the specialty of prosthodontics in Vancouver.



William (Bill) Liang, BSc, DMD

William (Bill) Liang is a committed CDSBC volunteer and mentor to members of the dental profession.

Bill has made a considerable contribution to CDSBC's committees since 1996. He served on the CDSBC Quality Assurance

Committee for nine years, and chaired the Continuing Education Subcommittee for three years. He was also a member of the Dental Practice Guidelines and Clinical Practice Guidelines working groups.

Bill received his bachelor's degree in microbiology in 1981 and his Doctorate of Dental Medicine in 1983 from UBC. At graduation, he was awarded the Canadian Oral and Maxillofacial Prize for highest standing in the area of oral surgery. He earned his board certification in 2004 by the American Board of Oral Implantology.

During his 29 years in practice, Bill's interests and education have evolved into the area of oral implantology. His restorative philosophy is largely shaped by his

mentor, Dr. Richard Tucker, and he is a past president of the Academy of R.V. Tucker Study Clubs. His practice is currently focused on adult restorative and implant dentistry.

As well, Bill spends a significant amount of time and energy mentoring dentists in the field of oral implantology. As the Director of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry (AAID) Vancouver MaxiCourse, and Founder of the Canadian Dental Implant Training Centre, Bill is devoted to educating his colleagues.

He is the current President of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry Western District, and holds five fellowships: the Academy of General Dentistry; American Academy of Implant Dentistry; Academy of Dentistry International; American College of Dentists; and the Misch Implant Institute.

Bill is also a Diplomate of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists and the American Board of Oral Implantology.

Betty Richardson

Betty Richardson has shared her enthusiasm and expertise with CDSBC since 1992.

In that time, she has held an impressive number of positions at the College. From assistant in the Registrar's Office to Complaint

Officer, Manager of Complaints to Manager of Human Resources and CDA Regulation – Betty rose through the ranks at CDSBC.

Not one to avoid a challenge, Betty took on the multi-faceted role of Manager of CDA Regulation, Human Resources and Operations before being promoted to Director of Operations in 2004. In fact, before her impending retirement in April 2012, Betty notes she has worked in every department at CDSBC except dentist registration and communications.

Betty's career highlights include implementing several changes to the process for handling complaints, setting

up CDSBC's HR department, and developing all operational systems at the College.

As Director of CDA Regulation, Betty strived for CDA equality across the country. She worked on a labour mobility agreement as a national initiative for CDAs, and incorporated the NDAEB exams under the umbrella of regulation for CDAs in B.C.

One of Betty's most rewarding projects was jointly managing the entire building upgrade of College Place, a task that allowed her to develop a multitude of different skills. Over the years, Betty was given many challenges and opportunities that she took on enthusiastically. She is incredibly efficient in handling the hundreds of tasks that come across her desk, and she is a compassionate and caring leader.

In the past 19-and-a-half years, Betty has been involved in several CDSBC committees, sat on search committees for deputy registrars, and had a hand in hiring nearly everyone who works at the College.

Honoured Member Award

The Honoured Member Award is presented to individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the art and science of dentistry or to the dental profession over a sustained period of time. Contributions must be broad-based in nature and have impacted the practice or profession of dentistry in B.C. (significant contributions specifically to the College are not required). This award may be for service that is provincial, national or international in nature and is also available to people who are not registered or certified with CDSBC.



David Sweet, O.C., DMD, PhD

David Sweet has made an enormous contribution to dentistry on a provincial, national and international level.

David is credited with inventing the process for extracting DNA from teeth for body identification.

His work has not just benefitted dentists; it has benefitted the public, thereby raising the profile of dentistry across the board.

In recognition of his significant achievements and remarkable service, Governor General Michaëlle Jean invested David as an Officer of the Order of Canada in 2008 for his work in forensic science as a teacher, researcher and consultant.

David regularly visits crisis scenes, and is currently the lead forensic odontologist for Disaster Victim Identification Canada. He was also chief forensic odontologist scientist on the INTERPOL Disaster Victim Identification Standing Committee from 2005 to 2011.

After graduating from UBC with a Doctorate of Dental Medicine in 1978, David maintained a private dental practice in Cranbrook, BC until 1984, when he was invited to return to UBC as a faculty member. Since 1987, David has been in charge of Oral Diagnosis in the undergraduate curriculum.

In 1992, David was designated a certified specialist in forensic dentistry (DABFO) by the American Board of Forensic Odontology. In 1995, he graduated from the University of Granada, Spain with a PhD (cum laude) in forensic medicine. David's doctoral thesis focused on the collection and analysis of forensic DNA evidence deposited on human skin during biting and kissing.

David volunteered for CDSBC from 1985 until 2004. His most notable contributions were to the General Examination Committee and Task Force on Dental Records.

He is currently a professor of forensic odontology and oral diagnosis for the UBC Faculty of Dentistry, and the Director of the Bureau of Legal Dentistry (BOLD) Laboratory at UBC. For the latter, David continues to pursue improved methods to apply basic sciences and modern forensic techniques to collect evidence from crime scenes, thereby assisting the justice system in North America.
