In memory of Honoured Member, *Dr. Richard Tucker*

Dr. Richard Vaughn Tucker passed away earlier this year, shortly before his 93rd birthday. He was a caring and innovative general dentist who practised in Ferndale, Washington and dedicated his life to developing a cast gold restorative technique that endures to this day. Dr. Tucker started his first study club dedicated to teaching his technique in Vancouver in the 1970s. The Academy of RV Tucker Study Clubs grew out of this initial club and now numbers 73 clubs worldwide.

Dr. Tucker will be remembered for his excellence and skill in dentistry as well as his love for teaching. Among the many awards he received in his lifetime, he was very proud to have received an honorary membership in the College of Dental Surgeons of BC.

Ms. Catherine Baranow, CDA



Catherine Baranow has been a member of CDSBC's Quality Assurance Committee since 2009. She served as the CDA member of the Continuing Education Subcommittee and was Chair of the Prosthodontic Working Group.

Following her graduation from Douglas College's Certified Dental Assisting Program in 1982, she worked in general practice as a CDA. In 2004 she completed a Master of Education at Simon Fraser University.

Catherine has been an instructor and chairperson for the Certified Dental Assisting Department

at Okanagan University College since 1995. She also teaches in Continuing Education at Okanagan College and notably revised the second edition course on the Prosthodontic Module. As an instructor, Catherine facilitates and interacts closely with CDAs.

Ms. Sandra Harvey, CDA



Sandra Harvey joined CDSBC's volunteer network in 2006, when she was vice-chair of the CDA Advisory Committee. She was a member of the CDSBC Board from 2007 to 2008, and a member of the Quality Assurance

Committee from 2007 to 2008.

Sandra completed the Certified Dental Assisting Program in 1982. She later graduated from Vancouver Community College with a Diploma in Adult Education and the Provincial Instructor Certificate. She worked as a clinical and didactic instructor and department head of West Coast College of Health Care's Certified Dental Assisting Program from 2003 to 2007.

Award of Merit

At his graduation, Scott was recognized by the Canadian Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, and the societies for periodontics and pediatric dentistry.

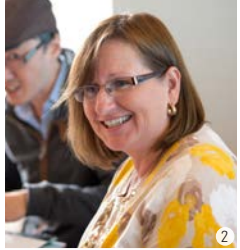

Dr. Bruce Ward



Dr. Bruce Ward's involvement with CDSBC spans over 30 years. He has served on the CDSBC Board on two different occasions and was a proud member of the College's Ethics Committee, and chair of the College Education

Committee. He was the chair of the Regulatory Review Task Force, chaired the Practice Standards Committee, and is currently the vice-chair of the Discipline Committee.

Bruce was part of the Minimal and Moderate Sedation Working Group, which was presented with CDSBC's Special Group Award in 2015 for developing the new standards and guidelines document that will assist B.C. dentists in the delivery of safe and effective minimal and moderate sedation. Bruce's ongoing commitment to the College has been recognized with an Award of Merit and the Distinguished Service Award.

Bruce received his Dental Degree from McGill University in 1976. He practiced as an associate in

North Vancouver for nine years and subsequently moved to a group practice in Coquitlam with two of his McGill classmates, where he worked for over 20 years. During this time, Bruce was also a practice management instructor and part-time faculty member at UBC Dentistry.

Bruce has generously volunteered his time to academic, community and professional dental organizations. He was the director of the Eastside Walk-In Dental Clinic and continues to volunteer there. He has served as president of the British Columbia Dental Association and continues to serve as the BCDA media spokesperson and chair of the BCDA Dental Mentorship Program. Bruce currently volunteers for the Pacific Dental Conference, the National Dental Examining Board, and is a speaker for UBC Dentistry's Professionalism and Community Service Program.
