CDSBC Launches Dental Recordkeeping Online Course

CDSBC is proud to present its first interactive online course: Dental Recordkeeping.

What is it?

Dental Recordkeeping is a six-module online course that takes approximately three hours to complete. The course can be completed at your own pace and has options for both visual and auditory learning styles. Knowledge checks and interactive scenarios will test your comprehension before each new module is unlocked.

What will I learn?

The online course covers the principles of good recordkeeping (both paper and electronic) and how to:

- Collect and update medical and dental history
- Properly record diagnosis and treatment planning
- Obtain and note a patient's informed consent
- Ensure patient privacy and confidentiality
- Maintain financial and drug records
- Retain and dispose of dental records

Who can take the course?

The course is open to registrants, other dental professionals and the public.

Can I earn continuing education (CE) credits?

Registrants who complete the course can submit for three CE self-study credits in the practice management category. Any dental professionals not registered with CDSBC will have to approach their own regulatory body to determine whether they can use the course to fulfil their CE requirements.

How much does it cost?

The course will be free of charge until March 1, 2014. After March 1, anyone can access the course free of charge; however, there will be a fee for those who require proof of completion for CE submissions.
