



CDSBC offers \$2,000 reward for information leading to the arrest of Mr. Tung Sheng (David) Wu

August 15, 2013

Yesterday afternoon, August 14, our lawyers appeared before Associate Chief Justice Cullen and obtained an order as follows:

1. Declaring that the arrest warrant issued by the Court on August 12 for Tung Sheng Wu to appear before the court may be executed anywhere in Canada;
2. Authorizing the College to enter on to the premises of J-Link Transportation in Richmond, B.C. to seize and search Mr. Wu's 2013 Acura RDX vehicle; and
3. To report back to the Court on the results of its actions.

Late yesterday afternoon, the College seized the vehicle. We have begun the process of searching the contents and recording our findings for the court. I am not permitted to provide a detailed inventory of what we have found, but can say that we have recovered documents, personal effects, and a large quantity of dental supplies. We understand that the vehicle was to be shipped to Toronto.

Our investigators are working on a number of tips. Our efforts to locate and apprehend Mr. Wu continue. Anyone with information about where Mr. Wu is hiding can contact our investigators in confidence at **604-209-1708**, or if they feel more comfortable doing so, may contact the police.

The College is offering a reward of \$2,000 to any person who provides us information leading to Mr. Tung Sheng Wu's arrest. Any person harbouring Mr. Wu can contact us in confidence. We will apprehend him without need to reveal where, or with whom he was staying. The important thing is that Mr. Wu appears before the Court to answer for his actions.

We ask the media to continue to publicize the need for persons who had contact with Mr. Wu to get tested for infection and to visit a licensed dentist to ensure proper, competent and **safe** dental care is received.
